TOWN OF HARRISON

The regular monthly meeting for the Town of Harrison was held at Northland Church on Monday, February 9, 2026. Notice of the meeting was posted according to standards set by Wisconsin Statutes. Chairman Dean Lashua called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. Present at the meeting were Dean Lashua, John Phillips, Carrie Powell, Brandon Schuster, Arnie Kaminski and Megan Guzman.

The Clerk's minutes from the previous meeting were read. A motion was made by John Phillips and second by Dean Lashua to accept the minutes. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. The beginning balance on January 1, 2026, was \$504,487.85. Deposits for the month totaled \$359,584.66 and the total expenses were \$418,091.25 leaving an ending balance on January 31, 2026, of \$443,981.26. The Money Market balance on January 1, 2026, was \$137,615.26. The Money Market account collected \$16.97 in interest so the balance at the end of the month is \$137,632.23.
